2021 ANNUAL MEETING GUIDE

I. Annual Meeting Date

The 2021 Annual Meeting of Shareholders of GATX Corporation (the “Company”) will be held on Friday, April 23, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Central Time. The record date for determining shareholders entitled to vote at the meeting was February 26, 2021.

The proxy materials for the 2021 Annual Meeting were sent to shareholders beginning on March 12, 2021.

II. Rules of Conduct

In order to provide a meeting that is informative and fair to all shareholders in attendance, the Company has established the following Rules of Conduct:

1. You need to have held shares as of the close of business on the record date, February 26, 2021, to vote or submit questions at the virtual Annual Meeting. To vote or submit questions, please login as a shareholder by entering the 15-digit control number you received with your proxy materials in the field provided in the web portal.
2. Questions may be submitted at or before the time the matters are before the Annual Meeting for consideration. If you have voted your shares or submitted your questions prior to the start of the Annual Meeting, there is no need to vote those shares or submit those questions during the Annual Meeting. Non-shareholder guests will not be permitted to submit questions.
3. Recording the Annual Meeting is prohibited.
4. The meeting will follow the Agenda provided in the Company’s virtual Annual Meeting web portal and announced by the Chairman or other presiding officer (“Presiding Officer”). Only those items of business of which the Company’s Corporate Secretary has received proper notice will be acted on.
5. The Presiding Officer will present the items of business to the shareholders. The Presiding Officer will respond only to questions about the items of business to be voted on by the shareholders and will answer questions before the voting is closed.
6. We will limit each shareholder to two questions. Questions should be succinct and cover only one topic per question. Questions from multiple shareholders on the same topic, or that are otherwise related, may be grouped, summarized and answered together.

7. Matters unrelated to the items of business, of individual concern to a shareholder, or any question posed not otherwise answered, may be raised separately, after the Annual Meeting, by contacting Investor Relations at ir@gatx.com or 312-621-6262.
8. The views and comments of all shareholders are welcome. The Presiding Officer has the authority to maintain the decorum of the Meeting as necessary and the purpose of the Meeting will be observed.
